



Memorandum of Understanding

between



**Goa College of Pharmacy
Panaji-Goa.**

and

**V.M. Salgaocar College of Law,
Miramar - Goa.**

Whereas, this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by the Goa College of Pharmacy, 18th June Road, Panaji-Goa and V.M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar-Goa, one of the pioneering institutes in legal education in India and abroad (*hereinafter referred to jointly as the 'parties'*).

Whereas, the parties having discussed the field of common interests for training, research and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a mutual collaboration.;

Whereas, Pharmacy profession in Goa is the oldest in the Indian subcontinent. The first ever Pharmacy course was introduced along with the medical course in 1842 at the Old Portuguese school known as "Escola Medica de Goa" and later named as "Escola Medica Cirurgica de Goa". The Pharmacists (pharmaceutics) and Doctors (Medica Cirurgiao) were educated and trained in the same medical school and they had almost the same status in the Goan Society.

In the year 1963, after liberation of Goa in 1961, the institute was renamed as "GOA COLLEGE OF PHARMACY" and shifted to the present premise which was formerly a Portuguese school. This pharmacy course was upgraded to a full-fledged degree course of Bachelor of Pharmacy under University of Bombay. Diploma in Pharmacy course was started in 1966. Later in 1970, the college was recognized for Master's degree in Pharmacy entirely by Research, under University of Bombay.

After the formation of Goa University in the year 1985, Goa College of Pharmacy since then is affiliated to Goa University. Goa College of Pharmacy runs under the aegis of Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Goa. It is approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

Goa College of Pharmacy offers Diploma in Pharmacy, Bachelors in Pharmacy, Master in Pharmacy (Quality Assurance being introduced in 1992; Pharmacology in 2003, Pharmacognosy in 2010 and Pharmaceutical Chemistry in 2021). Goa College of Pharmacy is a recognized Research Center for Ph. D. Program since 2014, having to offer Doctorate in Pharmacy.

Whereas, V.M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar-Goais a premier Institution in the State of Goa that provides for higher education and is actively involved in research, training and consultancy. In the third cycle college has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.56 out of 4.00. Law College being professional College doesn't not come under NEP, 2020 to join cluster institutes, hence we would like to enter into MOU with Goa College of Pharmacy to collaborate and organize seminar/workshop/conference/project etc.

Whereas, there is a need for both parties to work jointly in order to efficiently achieve their goals through mutual sharing and cooperation and collaborate for mutual benefit.

Now, therefore, the parties agree to as follows:

Article - I

1. The purpose of this MoU is to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration between the parties to meet the broader goals of training and capacity building of pharmacy students, faculty members of the Goa College of Pharmacy. This collaboration would enable
 - (a) to conduct a number of training programmes thereby trying to achieve the targets as mandated in the State Training Policy of Goa.
 - (b) to cater to the training programme for the students and faculty members of both the institutes respectively in the field of pharmacy and law.



Article - II

2. The parties agree to cooperate in the following areas of activity:
- (a) to conduct training programmes allotted by the respective institutes.
 - (b) to provide faculty support in conducting the programmes at their premises.
 - (c) to collaborate in research activities wherever the need arises.
 - (d) to provide student support wherever needed for minor data collection.
 - (e) to provide their infrastructure to conduct the training programmes, workshops, seminars, symposia, etc.,
 - (f) to promote collaborative academic exchange through faculty, students, lectures and publications.

Article – III

Implementation of Memorandum of Understanding

- 3.1 All activities mentioned herein will be conducted as stipulated in the MoU.
- (a) There is no financial liability on the part of Goa College of Pharmacy. Our faculty will engage relevant lectures to the students and faculty as per the requirements.
 - (b) The Institute concerned will adhere and provide the necessary arrangements required for conducting the programme as per details given in the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) to be determined by the parties to this MoU from time to time.
- 3.2 Neither party shall be agent, representative, or joint partner of the other party. Neither party shall enter into any contract or commitment on behalf of the other party.
- 3.4 Neither party shall use the name, logo of the other party or any abbreviation thereof without the prior written approval of the other party.

- 3.5 Nothing in this MoU grants either party the permission to create a hyperlink to the other's website, without the written authorization of the other party.

Article – IV


Term, Termination and Amendment

- 4.1 The proposed MoU is non-exclusive and shall be in force for a period of *two years* w.e.f. the date commencing on 20.04.2023 and ending on 19.04.2025, unless terminated prior to the date of ending, upon mutual agreement by the parties.
- 4.2 The MoU may be amended mutually by written agreement of the parties.
- 4.3 Goa College of Pharmacy will reserve the right for weekly monitoring of the programmes and related activities assigned to the party.

This MoU is being signed on this 20 day of the month of April in the year 2022 and shall remain in force till 19.04.2025




