# Memorandum of Understanding

The present Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2023

by and between

**GOA POLICE,** the law enforcement agency for the State of Goa with Office of the Director General of Police, Goa Police, Police Headquarters, Panaji Goa 403001 and the Home Secretary of Goa as Head of the State Police, hereafter referred to as GOA POLICE, which expression shall mean and include its successors in office and assigns and represented by its representatives.

Devi Sharvani Education Society's V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar, Goa, affiliated to Goa University, hereinafter referred to as VMSCL, hereby represented by its Officiating Principal, Dr. G. Shaber Ali.

*Whereas*, the parties having discussed the field of common interests for training, research and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a mutual collaboration.;

*Whereas*, V.M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar-Goa is a premier Institution in the State of Goa that provides for higher education and is actively involved in research, training and consultancy. In the third cycle college has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.56 out of 4.00. Law College being professional College doesn't not come under NEP, 2020 to join cluster institutes, hence we would like to enter into MOU with your esteemed institution to collaborate and organize seminar/workshop/conference/project etc.

Whereas, there is a need for both parties to work jointly in order to efficiently achieve their goals through mutual sharing and cooperation and collaborate for mutual benefit.

Now, therefore, the parties agree to as follows:

### <u>Article - I</u>

1. The purpose of this MoU is to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration between the parties to meet the broader goals of training and capacity building of Police officials, and other members of the Goa Police. This collaboration would enable

(a) to conduct a number of training programmes thereby trying to achieve the targets as mandated in the State Training Policy of Goa.

(b) to cater to the training programmes for the Police officials and Member of both the institutes respectively in the field of Maintenance of Law & Order.

## <u>Article - II</u>

- 2. The parties agree to cooperate in the following areas of activity:
  - (a) to conduct training programmes allotted by the respective institutes.
  - (b) to provide faculty support in conducting the programmes at their premises.
  - (c) to collaborate in research activities wherever the need arises.
  - (d) to provide student support wherever needed for minor data collection.

- (e) to provide their infrastructure to conduct the training programmes, workshops, seminars, symposiums, etc.
- (f) to promote collaborative academic exchange through faculty, students, lectures and publications.

#### <u> Article – III</u>

#### Implementation of Memorandum of Understanding

3.1 All activities mentioned herein will be conducted as stipulated in the MoU.
(a) Financial support for training of police personnel shall be borne by Goa Police. There is no other direct financial obligations on either institution unless specifically agreed to. The financial requirement of individual institutions for joint project proposals will be separately mentioned in joint projects while submitting to funding agencies. Before start of any activity, financial terms will be decided pertaining to that particular activity in advance.

(b) The Institute concerned will adhere and provide the necessary arrangements required for conducting the programme as per details given in the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) to be determined by the parties to this MoU from time to time.

- 3.2 Neither party shall be agent, representative, or joint partner of the other party. Neither party shall enter into any contract or commitment on behalf of the other party.
- 3.4 Neither party shall use the name, logo of the other party or any abbreviation thereof without the prior written approval of the other party.
- 3.5 Nothing in this MoU grants either party the permission to create a hyperlink to the other's website, without the written authorization of the other party.

## <u>Article – IV</u>

#### Term, Termination and Amendment

4.1 The proposed MoU is non-exclusive and shall be in force for a period of *two years* w.e.f. the date commencing on 20.03.2022 and ending on 19.03.2024, unless terminated prior to the date of ending, upon mutual agreement by the parties.

- 4.2 The MoU may be amended mutually by written agreement of the parties.
- 4.3 Goa Police will reserve the right for weekly monitoring of the programmes and related activities assigned to the party.
