About ADR Board

ADR Board of the College imparts training and exposure to students in Alternate Dispute

Resolution (ADR) through effective client counseling, negotiation and mediation. The Board

organizes orientation sessions for all students interested in being members of the ADR board,

thereby augmenting their participation in the National and International ADR competitions.

The enrolment of the students as members of the ADR Board undergoes a rigorous process of

selection round, wherein the students are given a problem (two days in advance), and

Confidential information (CI) 20 mins prior to their rounds which tests the skills of the students

to negotiate and come up with creative solutions on modern-day issues. On successful

completion of the selection rounds, the students are then selected to become members of ADR

Board.

The selected members are further trained and are given the opportunity to represent the college

at the National and International Competitions. The faculty coordinators / members of the

institute are instrumental in engaging several training sessions of the members who represent

the college at the National and International ADR competitions. Students of the college who

have achieved laurels in the preceding year 2022-2023 are equally involved in engaging the

trial rounds.

ADR Board also conducts compulsory Client Counselling sessions for final year students of

the BALL.B. and LL.B. Degree programmes, as part of their practical paper.

Selection to ADR Board

Notice was issued for the purpose of registration for selection rounds to the ADR Board on 3rd August 2023 and the last date to register was 22nd August 2023. The Selection Rounds were held on 25th August 2023 in 8 different halls at the College. Besides faculty members, alumni of the college having expertise in the field of ADR were also invited to preside over the selection rounds.

The declaration of the results was done on 28th August 2023.

ADR Board members: A total of 55 students were selected. Exemption from selection process was given to 11 former members who had achievements to their credit from previous year (2022 - 2023) National/International Competitions.

The selected members who participated at the National and International Competitions received coaching from Dr. B.S.Patil, Prof. M.R.K.Prasad, Practicing Adocates (through online meet). Several training sessions (mocks) were also conducted with the ADR selected students who had gained experience in the preceding year, through their participation in ADR Competitions representing the college.

Faculty coordinators presided over the meeting. The new members were welcomed to the ADR Board and the work culture and duties of members were discussed and assigned. Students were

The event was held at the SVKM'S NMIMS Kirit P. Mehta School of Law, Mumbai.

Along with the winner's trophy, Dias also received a cash prize of Rs. 18, 000 and a two-month internship offer from the law firm Wadia Ghandy and Company.

Joshua Dias, a student of 5th year BALLB at VM Salgaocar College of Law (VMSCL), Miramar, represented the ADR board of VMSCL and has won the 'Mediator award' at the SVKM's NMIMS Kirit P Meha School of Law; Mumbai, at the first International Negotiation and Meditation Competition in association with Wadia Ghandy and Co. The preliminary rounds were conducted in virtual mode and the subsequent rounds were conducted in physical mode.

In the quarter finals, he knocked out the team from Christ University, School of Law after which he proceeded to the semi-finals where he knocked out Ramaiah College of Law, Bengaluru. After making it to the finals, he went up against O P Jindal Global University, Law School where he created a dominating session and provided multiple alternatives and solutions in dispute resolution of



the problem in the finals session. He then went forward to be awarded the Winner Mediator of the competition. During the competition, he also mediated sessions of various national and international universities. Along with the winner's trophy, Joshua also received a cash prize of Rs 18,000 and a two month internship offer from one of India's prestigious law firms, Wadia Ghandy and Company.

The ADR Board of VMSCL, Goa offers a two – day Knowledge Sessions on the "The Art of Negotiation" which were held on 18th and 19th January 2024. They are training sessions that are conducted for students from all fields. This year there were 54 participants inclusive of 25

students from various Free Legal Aid Cells constituted in Goa. The sessions delve into the basics of negotiation and mediation and were conducted by trained professionals and experts in the field of mediation. They provide the opportunity to learn the essential skills and values to become an effective negotiator and a skilled mediator. These sessions were held on the following topics:

- 1. Effective communication & Online Mediation Skills
- 2. The Role of Power in Mediation: A Closer Look at Influence and Authority
- 3. Agenda Setting & Opening Statements
- 4. Introduction to Negotiation
- 5. Information Gathering for Parties
- 6. The Power of Storytelling in Negotiation: How Narrative Drive Resolutions

The sessions were engaged by,

Adv. Yukta Joshi – A licensed Advocate practicing before the High Court of Madhya Pradesh and NCLT at the Indore bench. She is also certified in Dispute Resolution Management by the Indian Institute of Arbitration and Mediation.

Josephine Reyes and Helen Miedzinski - Ms. Josephine Reyes is a mediator for Community Justice Centres of NSW State in Australia since 1984 up to the present. She Joined World Mediation Organization in 2013. Ms Helen Miedzinski is an experienced practitioner of Family Dispute Resolution (FDR) and Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) founding her own firm. She holds membership on numerous panels such as the NSW Law Society and Legal Aid NSW as a mediator, and coaching FDRP and ADR courses in the College of Law, Bond University and Relationships Australia.

Chirag Balyan – A founding faculty at National Law University Mumbai. He is a teacher, arbitrator, and mediator. He heads the Arbitration centre at the University and edits Indian Review of International Arbitration.

Prof. Dr Ram Krishna Mandava Prasad – A leading expert in clinical education in India. He is the first recipient of Vanderbilt Fulbright Scholarship in Clinical Legal Education and joined V.M Salgaocar College of Law in the year 1996. He is a member of several international

organizations such as Global Alliance for Justice Education, South Asian Forum of Clinical Law Teachers.
