MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Parties. This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between Ismailsaheb Mulla Law College, Satara, through it's Principal Dr. Deepa P. Patil and, whose address is, Ismailsaheb Mulla Law College, Karmaveer Samadhi Parisar, Powai Naka, Satara 415001,

and

V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Panaji, Goathrough it's Principal, Dr. G. Shaber Ali, whose address is, V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar, Panaji, Goa, Pin Code-403002.

2. Purpose. The MOU has been signed to offer additional options to law students to broaden their horizons in Law, legal literacy and to exchange legal expert knowledge, awareness of upcoming legal trends and legal aid.

The MOU focuses on the following areas:

- Encouraging Joint events of legal literacy programmes between both institutes through exchange of faculty and students in an online and offline mode.
- Conducting joint Legal Aid Camps and Legal Training Programs involving law students, advocates, Judicial Officers, social workers and faculty members.
- Hosting of Joint events and training programs for spreading awareness about legal literacy and Legal Aid.
- Collaborating on joint clinical programs for law students and members of society.
- Sharing of resources (Hostel, playground and Auditorium etc.) between the institutes and conducting mentorship programs for the students

3. Terms of MOU. This MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than **Five Years** from this date. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon one month's written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by email, or by certified mail to the address listed above.

This MOU reaffirms our mutual commitment to foster a better learning environment.

- Both the institutions will facilitate exchange of faculty and experts for expert lectures, guidance, Internship Activities, Para Legal Training and other co-curricular activities and skill development amongst students.
- Both the institutions shall make available the seminar hall/Lecture Hall with all amenities for the conduct of legal literacy Programmes at college as per prior mutual understanding of both the parties.
- Both the institutions shall allow open access for legal literacy and Legal Aid Programmes to be conducted by Dignitaries from the Court, their Invitees, Law

students, Advocates, faculty members, social workers and members from the community as per prior mutual understanding of both the parties.

- Both the institutions shall extend the cooperation in organizing various Legal Awareness Programmes in College or at such other place as per prior mutual understanding of both the parties.
- Both the institutions will facilitate sharing of resources such as hostel, playground, Auditorium etc. between the institutes

4. General Provisions

A. Amendments. Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

B. Applicable Law. The construction, interpretation and enforcement of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of India. In case of any dispute, the matter will be referred to the Arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of both the parties.

C. Financial Implications. The construction, interpretation and enforcement of this MOU shall not incur any financial burden on any of the party to this MOU.

D. Exchange of Correspondence. Both parties shall exchange mutual correspondence in writing or through electronic mail regarding conduct of the joint activities.

E. Severability. If any portion of this MOU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

F. Sovereign Immunity. Both the institutions and their respective governing bodies do not waive their sovereign immunity by entering into this MOU, and each fully retains all immunities and defenses provided by law with respect to any action based on or occurring as a result of this MOU.

G. Third Party Beneficiary Rights. The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third party beneficiary, and this MOU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU, and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU. The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MOU. The parties to this MOU intend and expressly agree that only parties signatory to this MOU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MOU, to seek any remedy arising out of a party's performance or failure to perform any term or condition of this MOU, or to bring an action for the breach of this MOU.

5. **Signatures.** In witness whereof, the parties to this MOU through their duly authorized representatives have executed this MOU on the day and date set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions of this MOU as set forth herein.
