TEACHING METHOD

The method of teaching involves lectures, discussions, seminars, case study, project work and submission of dissertation. The College hopes to involve expert legal faculties from different Universities by a method of co-operative teaching with greater amount of student involvement in the learning through clinical methodology. The project work stipulates library research, field investigation and legal writing which will be a valuable instrument of self-study under the direct supervision of the faculty.

The present curriculum is designed to make the students suitable to engage lectures after the completion of LL.M., course. As a part of this programme students are compulsorily required to take lectures in the presence of regular faculty to the BA.LL.B., /LL.B., programme. Besides this, students have to practice and prepare curriculum for various law courses.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is compulsory. The student who does not have 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear for the University examination and will be required to seek re-admission to the course.

CONTACT CLASSES

The Classes for the LL.M. Programme will be conducted throughout the week and the library facility will be available from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. six days a week.
