Awareness Program on Managing E-Waste



On 8th January 2021, the green initiative committee hosted a bulk consumer awareness programme for the teaching and non-teaching staff of V. M. Salgaocar College of Law. The programme was titled as “Managing E Waste, On and Off Campus- A guiding Session.” The programme's resource person was Assistant Professor Sushant Figueiredo. He began the session by explaining what e-waste is and how we, as consumers, affect the environment and the health of the people around us by not segregating e-waste.
