Young minds in politics

The faculty members of V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar have founded the Centre for Political Leadership (CPL) which trains students in politics

What is common between Gandhi, Ambedkar, Nehru, Mandela, Obama, Lincoln, and many other politicians? They were all lawyers turned politicians. And so, with the aim of introducing and training law students in politics, assistant professor at V. M. Salgaocar College of Law (VMCL), Miramar Ramani Naik conceived the idea of the Centre for Political Leadership (CPL) at the college. Together with faculty members B. S. Fatil, Priscilla Fernandes, and Siddhesh Tari, the centre was formally established on December 19, 2021, on the occasion of the 60th Goa Liberation Day. CPL seeks to introduce students to various aspects of political leadership. "The centre will push individual development and, at the same time, provide guidance for collective leadership. All its activities, despite having political nature, will only be initiated for the purpose of research, training, education, and skill development," says Naik who is also the director of the centre. CPL's main role, he says, is to convince students that political leadership is an achievable, attainable, and learnable skill. The centre will also make special efforts toward preparing female students in politics and facilitating their participation in politics.

One of the first initiatives organised under the centre was an All-Goa manifesto Writing Competition for the Goa Assembly Election 2022. The entries received were compiled into a compendium and submitted to all leading political parties before the election. The centre also organised a competition, Katan Borega

Political Analyst, where participants had to predict the winners of each Goa constituency correctly. "Previously, we have also held sessions on decoding the leadership styles of Gandhi, Ambedkar and Vladimir Putin. We also organised a roundtable conference on the topic of 'Revival of sports scenario in Goa' and submitted our vision plan to the government," says Naik.

Recently, the centre also experimented with an online election where all the students, faculty and staff members of the college could vote for the four newly formed students' political parties as part of CPL.

"We at CPL believe in the principle of 'Learn by Doing'. Therefore, all our future activities will be outcome-based and practical-oriented. We will train students

in public speaking, strategic and creative thinking, organisational expertise, problem-solving and crisis management, grassroots politics, social initiative and political analysis as well as political profession-specific skills such as party spokesperson, social media head, and other roles," says Naik, adding that for the first CPL membership drive, 147 VMCL students have enrolled. So far, any student of V. M. Salgaocar College of Law can enrol as a member and avail of benefits such as mentorship, projects and internship opportunities, meet and greet sessions with political leaders, and can attend team-building activities, debates and discussions, workshops, field trips and other events. In future, Naik says they will have short-term certificate courses for the general public.
