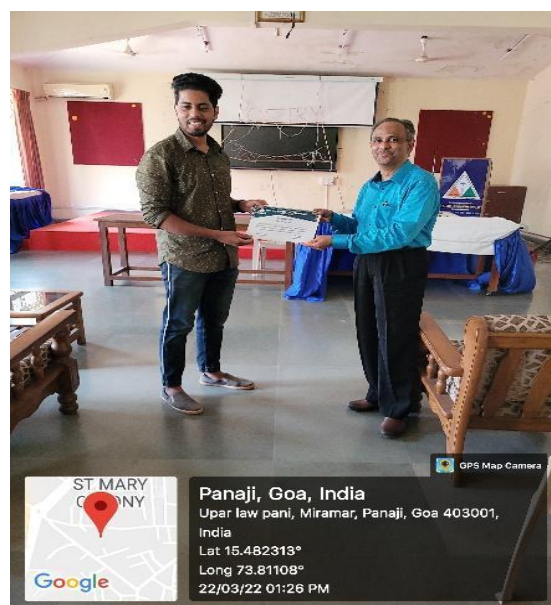

V. M. Salgaocar College of Law celebrated with great pride and enthusiasm, the 72nd Republic Day on 26th January 2021.

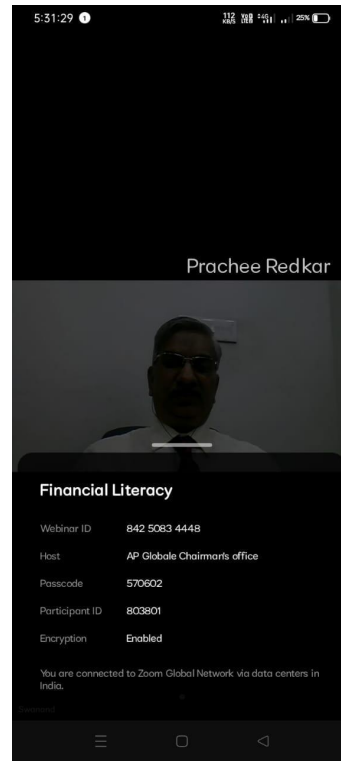
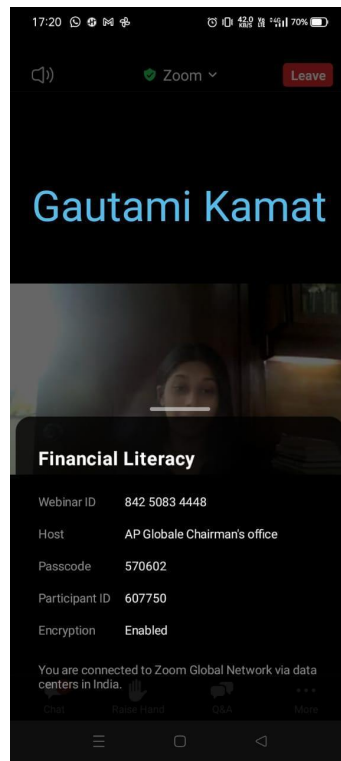
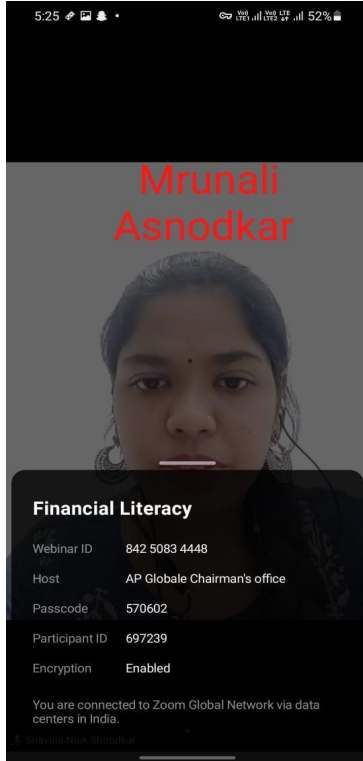
