Rosary College of Commerce & Arts, Navelim, battled hard to claim

the runners-up position, while Padre Conceicao College of Engineering, Verna, and VVM's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics, Margao, shared third place.

Inter-Collegiate Judo (W)

The competition's standout performer, Juliet Varghese from Goa Medical College & Hospital,

Bambolim, was named Best Judoka (Women) after storming to gold in the 52 kg division.

Gold medals were spread across several institutions — Tanishka Shivolkar (Don Bosco College, Panjim) dominated the 48 kg category, while Kalpita Naik (Rosary College) edged an all-Rosary final in the 57 kg class. In the 63 kg division, Isha

Fernandes (V.M. Salgaocar) produced a flawless run to the top of the podium.

Aditi Sadekar (Padre Conceicao College) took gold in the 70 kg bracket, while V.M. Salgaocar's Priti Kalmankar reigned supreme at 78 kg. In the +78 kg class, Numa Subba (Shree Damodar) out-muscled her opponents to strike gold.

VM Salgaocar College of Law, Miramar, stamped their authority as they clinched the Goa University Inter Collegiate Table Tennis Championship 2025-26 title for the second straight year with a convincing 3-1 victory over St Xavier's College, Mapusa, in the final.

Inter-Collegiate TT

Led by the in-form Khushi Naik, Salgaocar College stamped their authority early. Khushi set the tone by dismantling Pranavi Shetye 11-4, 11-3, 11-6. St. Xavier's responded through Stuti Shivani, who edged past Simran Kanekar 11-5, 8-11, 11-4, 11-4, drawing the tie level.

But Salgaocar's depth shone through as Arya Nadkarni clinched a hard-fought win over Puravi Shetye 12-10, 11-5, 11-9.

Khushi then returned to wrap things up, beating Stuti Shivani 11-6, 11-4, 14-12 to secure the championship.

In the semifinals, Salgaocar overcame Parvathi Chougule College of Arts & Science, Margao, 3-1, while St. Xavier's saw off Goa Medical College, Bambolim, by the same margin.

Khushi Naik's dominant run earned her the Best Player in Women's award for the second consecutive year, underscoring her pivotal role in Salgaocar's triumph.

The three-day championship witnessed spirited participation from 27 women's teams, reflecting the growing competitiveness of women's table tennis across Goa's colleges.
