


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is entered into on this Twenty Fourth Day of February, Twenty Twenty-Six, by and between:

DEVI SHARVANI EDUCATION SOCIETY'S V. M. SALGAOCAR COLLEGE OF LAW, Miramar, Panaji, Goa - 403002, represented by its Principal, Prof. Dr. Shaber Ali G, (hereinafter referred to as the "**The College**").



AND

STREET PROVIDENCE, a registered trust with the Government of Goa under Registration No. BRZ-BK4-00027-2017 dated 18th December, 2017 located at 169, Bella Vista Vaddo, Sangolda, Goa - 403511, represented by its Founder Trustee, Mr. Donald Fernandes, (hereinafter referred to as the "**The Trust**").



I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a formal collaboration for the publication of a booklet titled "**A QUICK GUIDE ON THE LEGAL RIGHTS & ENTITLEMENTS OF SENIOR CITIZENS IN GOA**" (hereinafter referred to as the "Booklet"), that is prepared by the members of Centre for the Rights of Older Persons (hereinafter referred to as "CROP")

II. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A. Responsibilities of the College:

- a) **Content Creation:** The College shall ensure that the student members of CROP prepare manuscript and design of the booklet, and update the same as and when required.



- b) **Quality Control:** The College faculty shall oversee the accuracy, language, and educational quality of the content.
- c) **Deadline Management:** The College will deliver the final digital manuscript to the Trust
- d) **Permissions:** The College will ensure that all student work is original and that students have consented to the publication.

B. Responsibilities of the Trust:

- a) **Publication:** The Trust shall bear all costs related to the professional printing, publishing, and physical / digital production of the Booklet, quantities of which will be requisitioned by CROP from time to time as per the requirement.
- b) **Distribution:** The Trust shall be responsible for distributing the Booklet to its target audience / beneficiaries.
- c) **Content and Design:** The Trust shall not make any alterations to the content manuscript provided by CROP. The booklet title, design and content shall be as drafted and provided by CROP.
- d) **Credits:** The College's name will feature in the Cover page and title of the booklet. The names of the contributing student members of CROP shall be added in the "Acknowledgements" or "Credits" section of the Booklet. The name of the Trust shall be added as the Publisher.
- e) **Information regarding the Trust:** The booklet shall contain two pages detailing information about the Trust, and the content for the same shall be provided by the Trust. The name of the Trust will also feature on the cover page as the publisher. The trust shall provide a copy of its 80-G certificate under the Income Tax Act to the College / CROP.

III. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY & OWNERSHIP

- a) The intellectual property of the content remains with the College / CROP.

- b) The **Trust** is granted a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to print, publish, and distribute the Booklet for a period of 2 years from the date of this MOU.
- c) Neither party shall use the other's logo or branding for any purpose outside of this specific Booklet without prior written consent.

IV. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) This collaboration is based on mutual benefit. No monetary exchange shall take place between the College and the Trust.
- b) The Booklet shall be distributed **Free of Cost** and shall not be used for commercial profit by either party.

V. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- a) This MOU shall remain in effect for a period of two years from the date on which it is signed by both the parties.
- b) Either party may terminate this MOU with a [30 days] written notice if the other party fails to meet its responsibilities.

VI. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes arising from this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation and negotiation between the heads of both organizations.
